Head of School Message

Happy Friday, everyone.

This week has seen our Year 1 children complete their Phonics Screening Check and our Year 4 children complete their Multiplication Tables Check. We are so incredibly proud of all of them; they did so well and approached their assessments with resilience and a positive attitude. Results of these statutory assessments will be shared with parents/carers alongside the end of year reports later in the term.

In addition to their usual curriculum timetable, all the children joined Steve Backshall for an online live lesson this week. Despite a few technical issues (due to the amount of schools joining from all over the UK!), the children loved learning more about life beneath the waves, exploring ocean habitats and ecosystems, and gaining insight into real-life conservation efforts.

This week's assemblies in schools have marked two special days in June: National Best Friends Day 2026 and World Oceans Day 2026. On Tuesday, we explored the theme of friendship. We talked about how the types of friendship groups we have may look different, what makes a good friend and how sometimes we can find making friends a bit tricky. Today, we explored why World Ocean Day is so important in coming together to ensure we have a healthy blue planet, linking beautifully to children's live lesson earlier in the week.

I was delighted to present the curriculum that we have developed this year to the Aspire Small Schools Network on Wednesday. The staff at St Keverne & Manaccan have played an integral part in this important piece of work; it was a privilege to share it with our wider colleagues to both celebrate the hard work that has gone in to developing it and share good practice.

We are rapidly approaching the end of this academic year, which I can't quite believe! The remaining weeks of this half term are full of end of year events, transition sessions, sports day and much more. We would love parents/carers to join us for a coffee morning on Friday 17th July 2026, where we can reflect on the past year, celebrate what has worked well and plan for the year ahead. 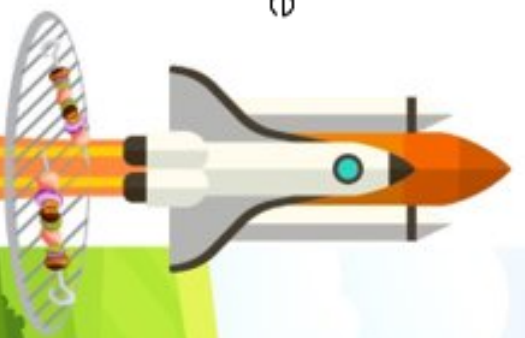

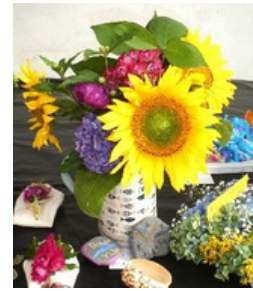
