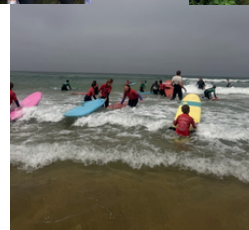
It was so rewarding to see the children work together, step out of their comfort zones and support one another.

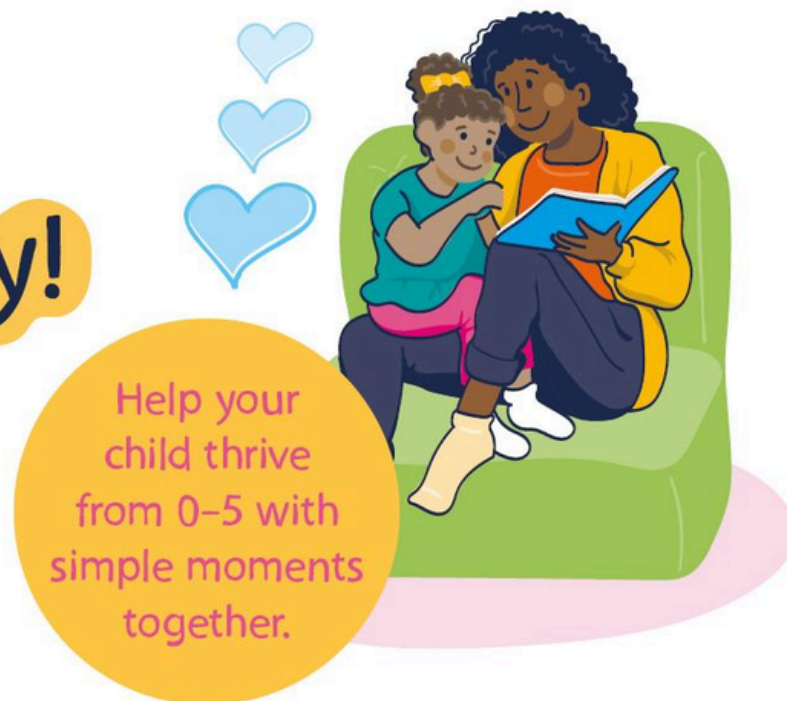
